Nature of support 2019/20

Based on the analysis of data in 2019 / 2020 the Pupil Premium funding was spent on:

Providing a pupil premium HLTA in upper Key Stage two providing targeted support in class and in SATs booster sessions.

Ensuring 'in class' support at Key Stage 1 and lower Key Stage 2 focussed on raising the attainment in phonics

Ensuring the difference in attainment between Pupil Premium pupils and other pupils was decreased. 'In class' support, providing high quality feedback to the oldest pupils was the mechanism to deliver this.

Impact

The impact was as follows:

Phonics - Due to Covid lockdown the children were not able to complete their phonics screening test, however termly analysis of progress before lockdown showed good progress in reading and writing for Pupil Premium children in early Key Stage Two.

At Key Stage 1 and 2 children did not take their Statutory Assessments due to Covid, however pupil premium children did receive targeted booster sessions to help diminish the difference and accelerate their learning.
