Following our initial taster visits, our full open day and evening will take place on Tuesday, 5th July. The open day for our new year 7 students will take place from 8.30am to 3.00pm, while the open evening for students and parents will take place between 5.00-8.00pm that day; this will provide all parents with the opportunity to meet their child's new year 7 tutor, along with many other members of staff.

I will be in touch again shortly with our final plans for the upcoming full open day and evening on Tuesday 5th July and to inform you all of your son or daughter's new tutor group arrangements, following the completion of our consultation with our local feeder primary schools. I will also provide you with further information in relation to the summer school that we will be running again this year between Monday 15th and Friday 26th August from 10.00am to 2.30pm each day. Attendance at the summer school will, of course, be voluntary and students can attend as many or as few of the sessions as they wish.
