### Impact

In the 2020-21 academic year Covid-19 meant that children had lost significant chunks of in-school learning and were therefore reliant on remote learning. Teachers provided online work and zoom meetings to give face to face lessons. The children sat 2019 SATS tests at the end of the summer in Year 6 and these were marked in class. The results for disadvantaged children were as follows:

Reading

83% at expected standard; 17% at greater depth

Maths

80% at expected standard; 20% at greater depth

Grammar, punctuation and spelling

92% at expected standard; 54% greater depth

The introduction of the ELSA programme meant children were able to verbalise their worries and concerns and allowed school to put strategies in place to support them
